

VAT Exemption Certificate

Please note there are penalties for making false declarations.

If you have a hearing disability, visual disability, or have a communicative disability you could maybe claim VAT exemption on our products.

To qualify for VAT exemption, you would need to be registered with a relevant disability with your local health authority or GP, suitable for the product you wish to purchase.

If you are in any doubt as to whether you are eligible to receive goods or services exempt from VAT you should consult your local VAT office before signing the declaration. The VAT Act 1983 provides for severe penalties for anyone who makes use of a document which they know to be false for the purpose of obtaining VAT Relief.
